It brings together Pivotal professionals, family members, and community resources to create a coordinated plan that meets the family's unique needs—at home, in school, and in the community.

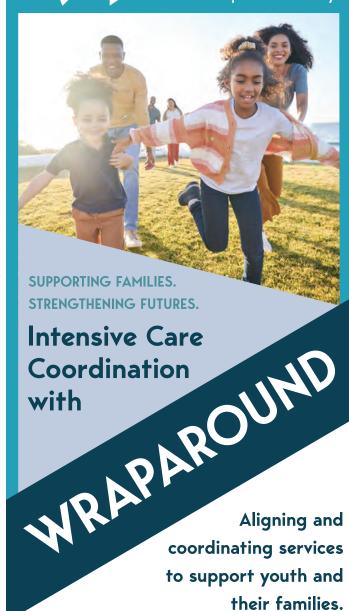

### **ELIGIBILITY**

Youth (typically ages 0–21) who are experiencing serious emotional, behavioral, or mental health challenges and are involved in—or at risk of involvement in—multiple systems (such as mental health, child welfare, juvenile justice, school challenges, or special education) are eligible for support.

ICCW is often for families who need intensive, coordinated support to help stabilize crises and create a long-term plan for success at home, in school, and in the community.

# REAL SUPPORT FOR REAL-LIFE STRUGGLES

If your child or teen is experiencing two or more challenges at home, in school, or in the community, ICCW may be the support you need. These challenges may include physical or verbal aggression, self-injury, poor decision-making, impulsiveness, criminal behavior, social difficulties, substance use or suspected use, running away, inappropriate or sexualized behavior, suicidal thoughts, or being at risk of academic failure or placement in a restricted setting outside the home.
